- Explore Colaba Causeway, Crawford Market
- Free time to explore on your own
- Overnight stay in Mumbai.

#### Day 4: Mumbai to Aurangabad

- Fly or take a train from Mumbai to Aurangabad.
- Check into your hotel and relax.
- Overnight stay in Aurangabad.

#### **Day 6: Ellora Caves Excursion**

- Marvel at the impressive Kailasa Temple, one of the largest monolithic structures in the world.
- Overnight stay in Aurangabad.

- Overnight stay in Agra.


#### Day 11: Agra to Delhi


- Drive back to Delhi from Agra.


